General Guide

Art Gallery of Viera is a family friendly venue. Participation in the gallery will be by jury selection. The gallery will seek a mixture of mediums by artists who are active and positive.

Artists joining the gallery will fill out a membership application, sign a contract, pay the non-refundable membership fee, and sign a release of liability form. Working members will be trained on basic gallery operation and personal expectations while staffing the gallery. The gallery reserves the right to terminate the membership of any artist who does not comply with standards and procedures. All members will be featured on the gallery's website, www.artgalleryofviera.com Members should also expect to participate in periodic special events promoting the gallery.

All artwork displayed in the gallery must be professionally presented and content must be approved. The gallery reserves the right to deny display to any pieces not deemed acceptable. If exhibiting in locations other than Art Gallery of Viera, pricing must be kept consistent.

To keep the gallery fresh and interesting, artwork will be changed periodically and artists will be responsible for rotating their art when scheduled. The gallery's decisions regarding placement of artwork are final. Payment to artists on sale of artwork will be available at the gallery or mailed within 15 days following the end of the month of the sale.

All decisions regarding membership, operations and policies will be made by the board of directors.

There are several configurations of space, each with its own unique shape (some taller & narrower, some shorter & wider) Each is considered a full space regardless of square footage. Artists will rotate through the various configurations over time. Lighting for all spaces is excellent.

Artists choosing 1/3 or 2/3 representation will share space with other 1/3 or 2/3 representation artists.
